When attaching hyperlinks to objects, only one hyperlink can be attached per object or area.

Solution

You must create an ASCII DWF file, which you can edit to include multiple URLs per object or area.

Example:

Open the ASCII DWF file in a text editor, here you will see the line which defines the URL:

```
(URL (0 http://www.autodesk.com ''))
```

The following lines show the changes you would make to include three URLs:

```
(URL (0 http://www.autodesk.com 'Home page')
(1 http://www.autodesk.com/support 'Support')
(2 http://www.autodesk.com/products
'Products'))
```

When you open the DWF file and move the cursor over the object, the status bar displays 'Multiple URLs' instead of the URL or file location. If you pick the object, a list of available URLs displays in a popup box. In this example 'Home page', 'Support', and 'Products' is displayed.
