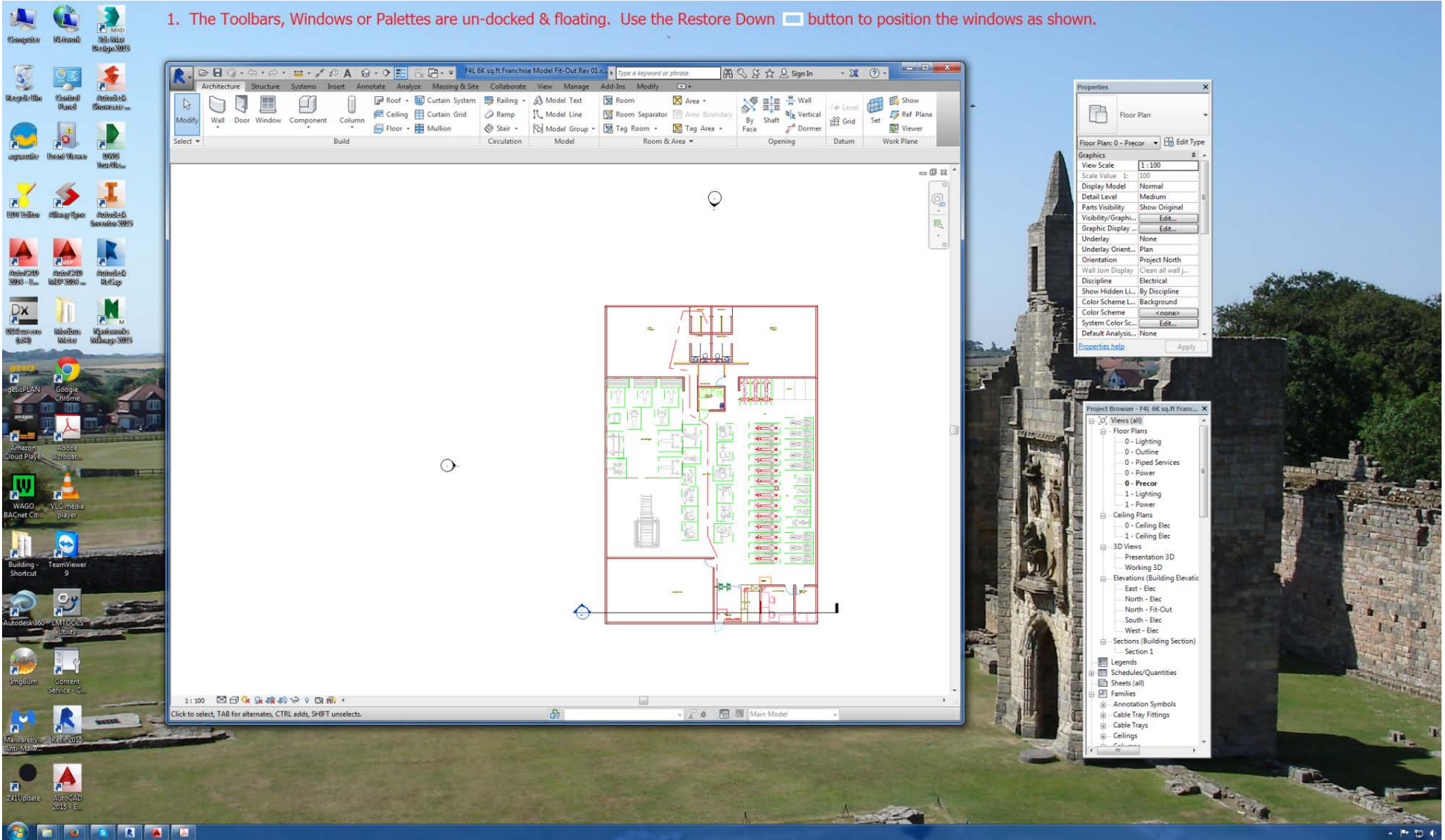
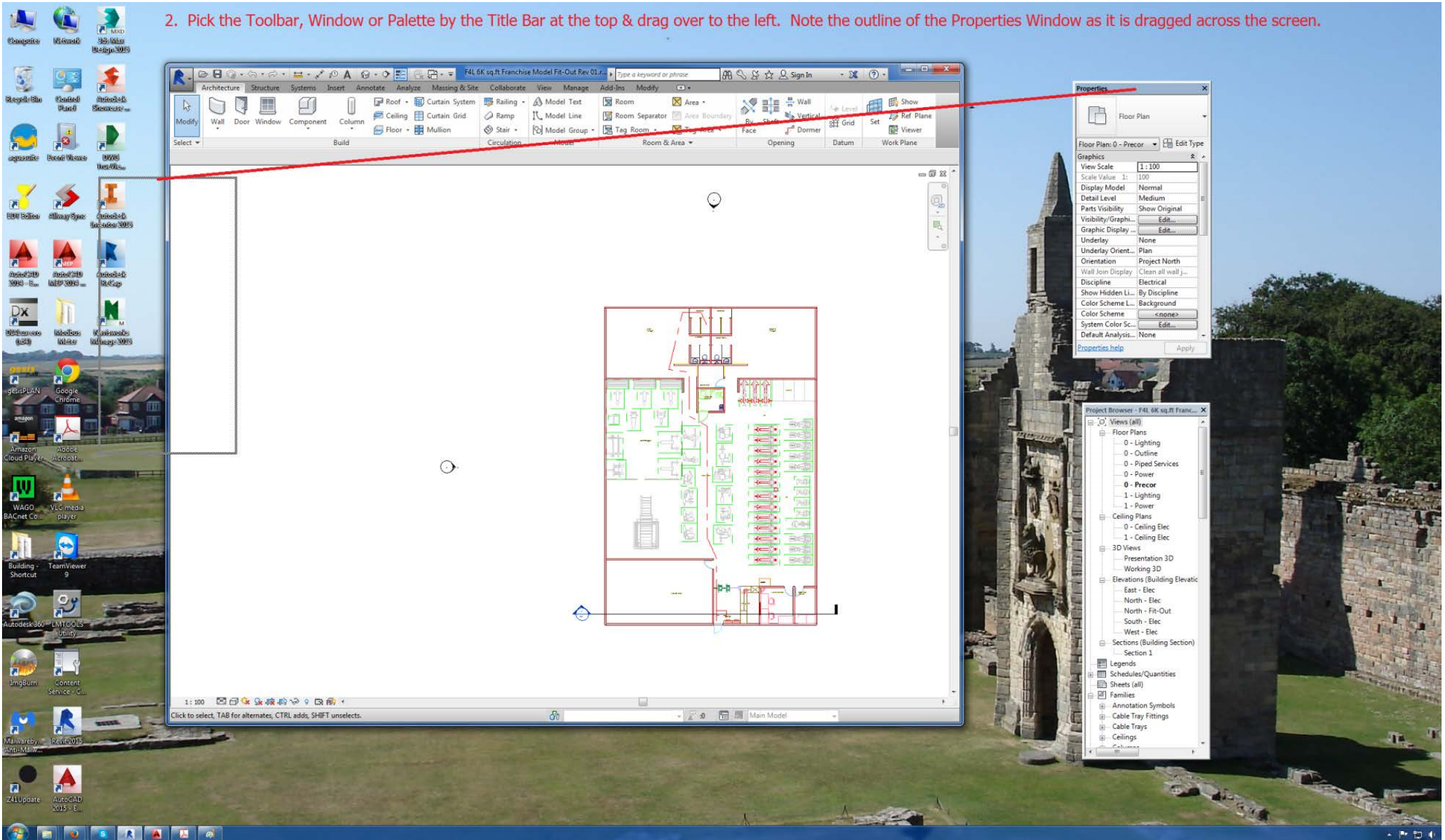


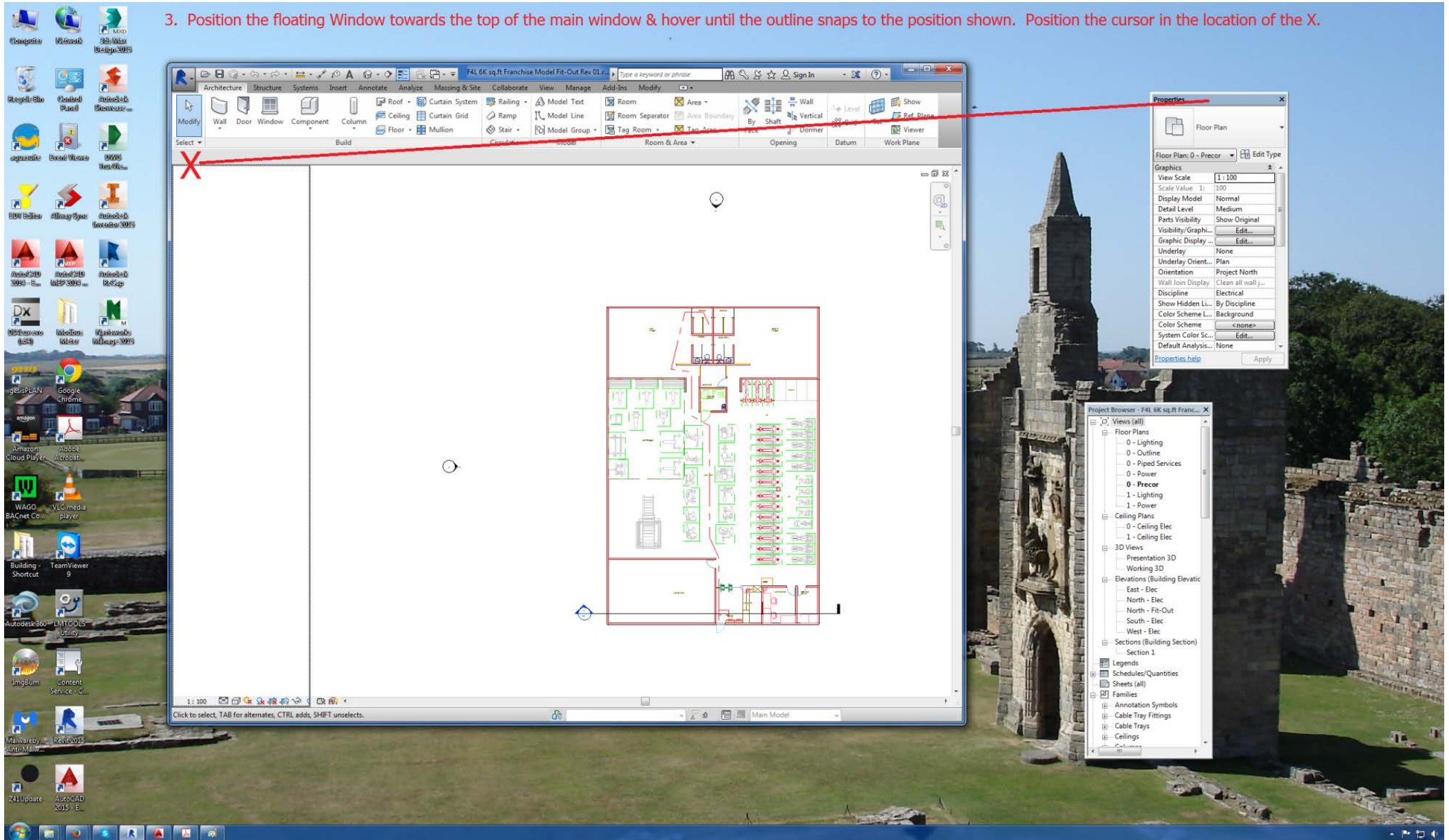
1. The Toolbars, Windows or Palettes are un-docked & floating. Use the Restore Down  button to position the windows as shown.



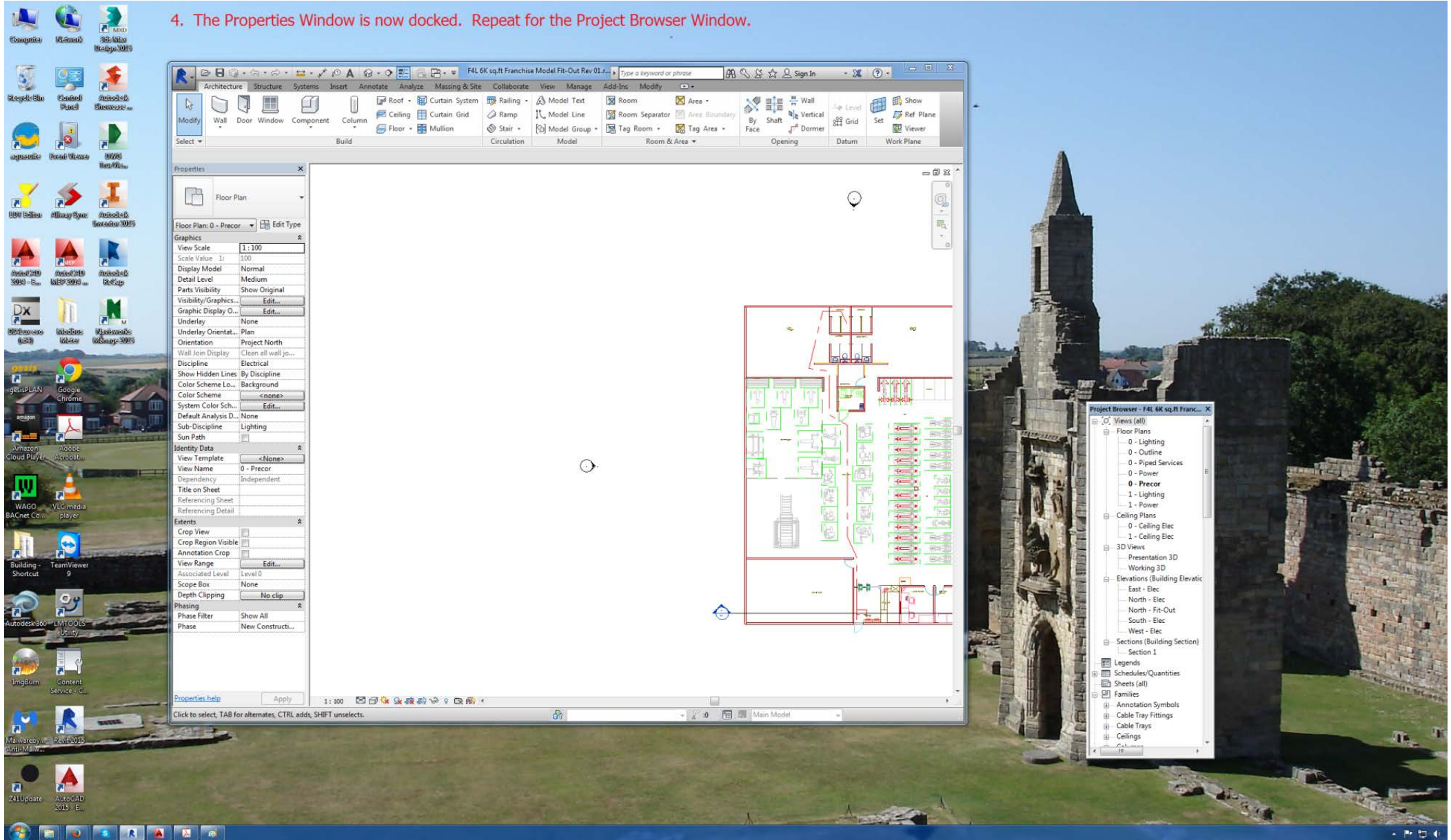
2. Pick the Toolbar, Window or Palette by the Title Bar at the top & drag over to the left. Note the outline of the Properties Window as it is dragged across the screen.



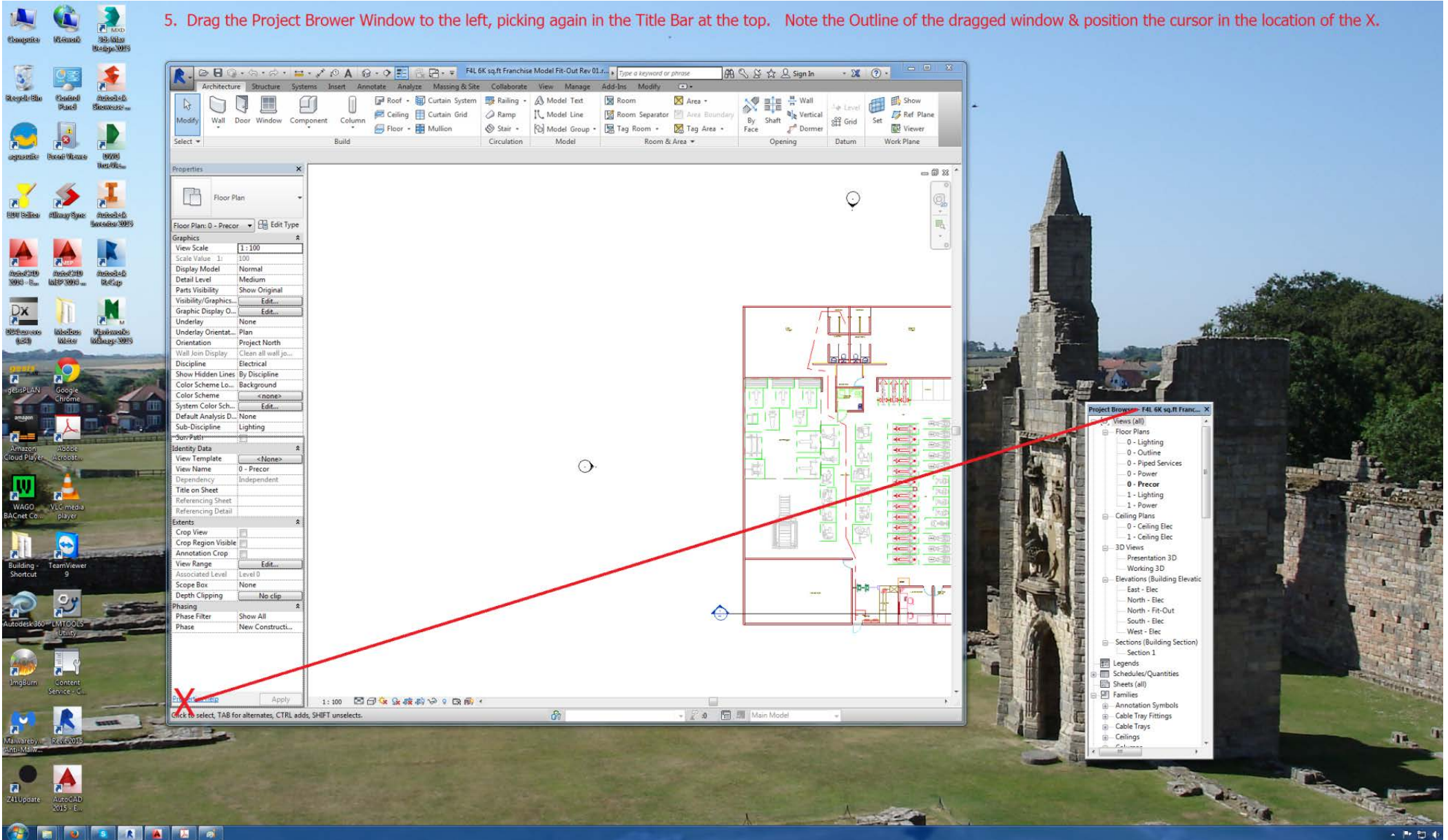
3. Position the floating Window towards the top of the main window & hover until the outline snaps to the position shown. Position the cursor in the location of the X.



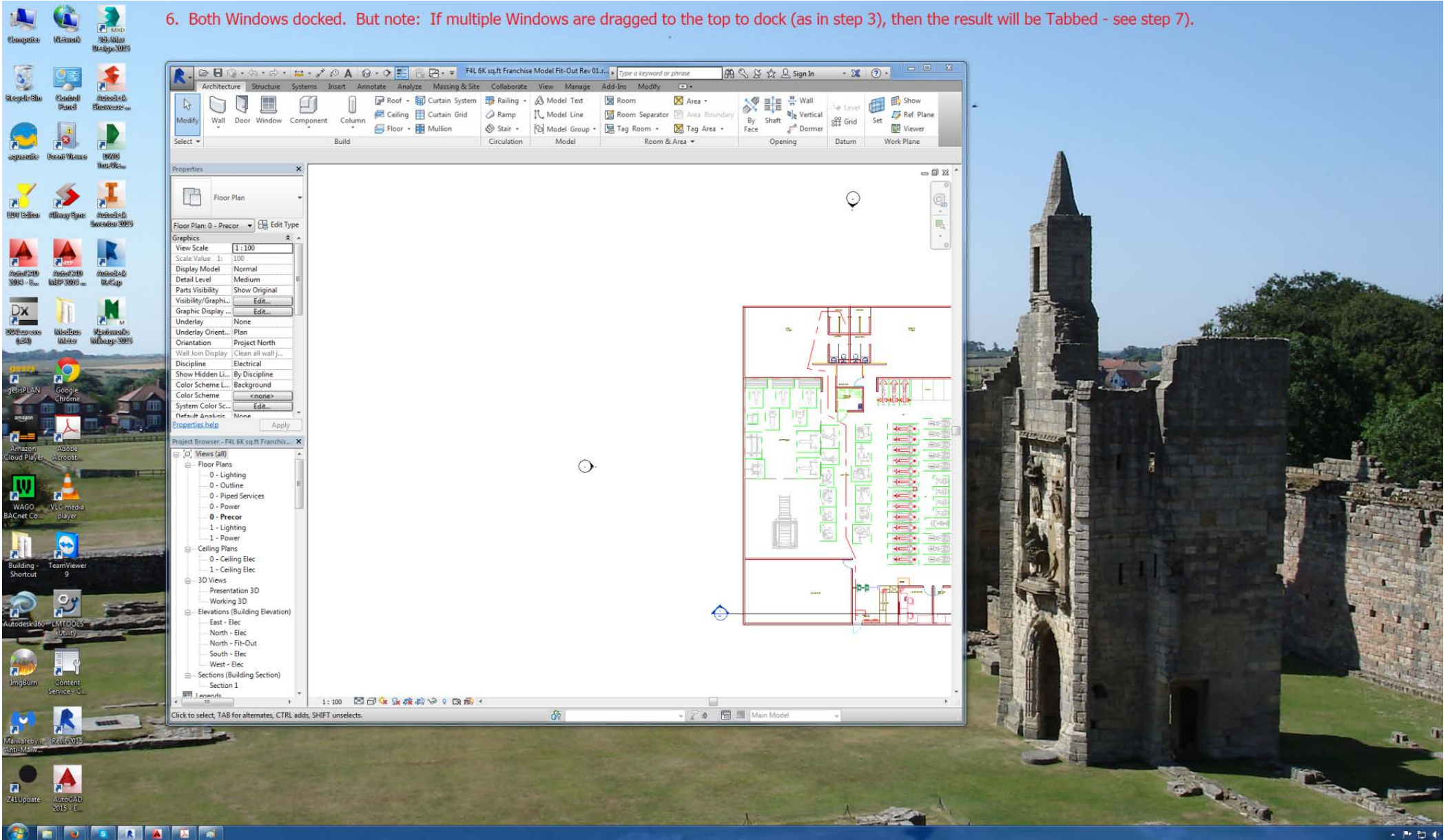
4. The Properties Window is now docked. Repeat for the Project Browser Window.

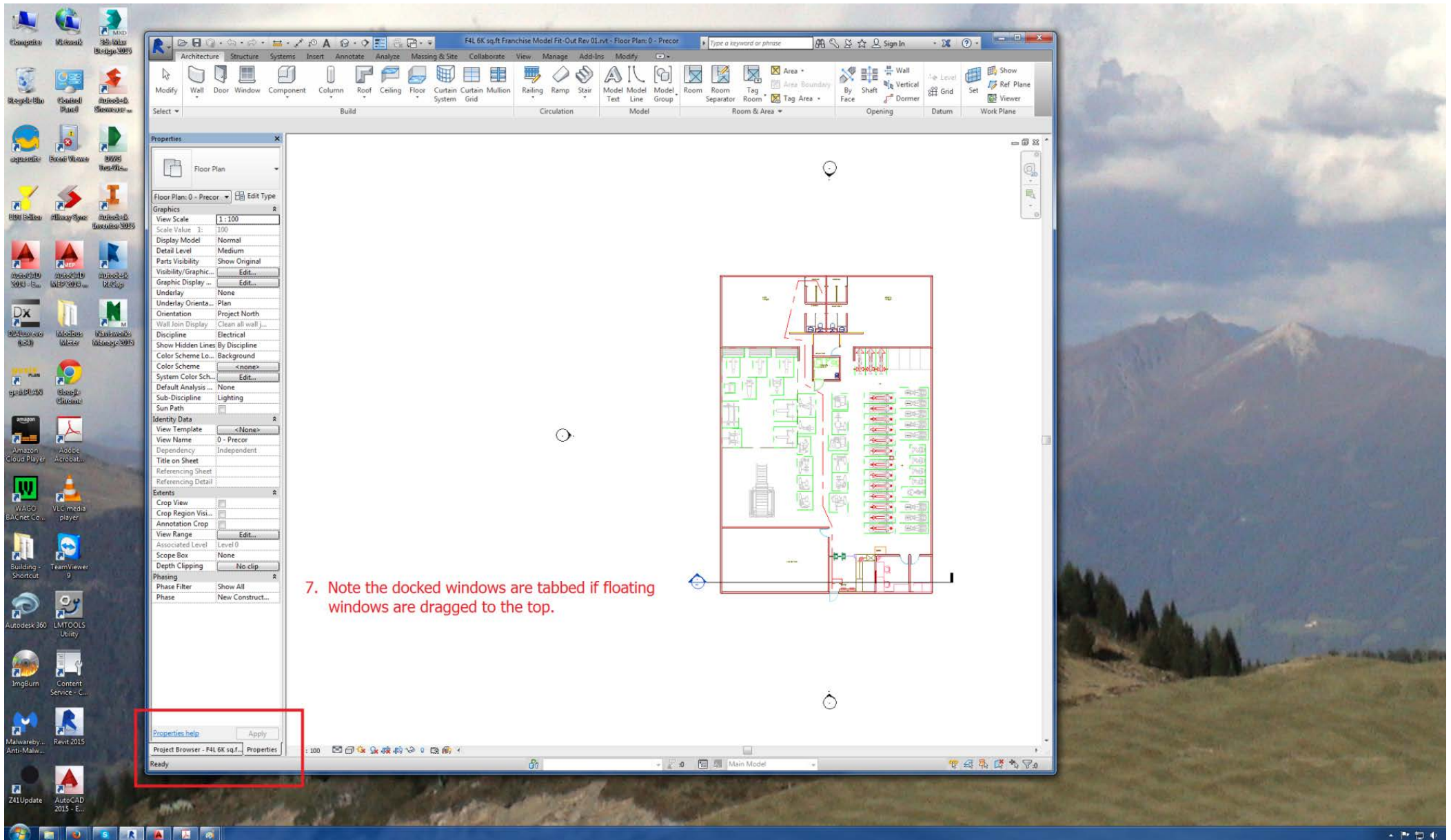


5. Drag the Project Brower Window to the left, picking again in the Title Bar at the top. Note the Outline of the dragged window & position the cursor in the location of the X.



6. Both Windows docked. But note: If multiple Windows are dragged to the top to dock (as in step 3), then the result will be Tabbed - see step 7).





7. Note the docked windows are tabbed if floating windows are dragged to the top.
