I use Bluebeam exclusively, but I imagine Adobe would work similarly. My apologies if Adobe doesn't have these tools. Here's my work around.

1. From Revit, print to PDF using "Create separate files. View/sheet names..." and I end up with individual pdfs named like this:

3. From Bluebeam, combine files (not including bookmarks, but including "Use Filename as Page Label")

Note: Even if I did accidentally include bookmarks or if Adobe doesn't have this option, I can always batch delete all bookmarks by highlighting all top-level bookmark names from the Bookmark menu after the pdfs are combined into one.

4. From the Bookmark menu, choose, "Create bookmarks" with the options to name them from Page Labels.

Note: If Adobe doesn't have this option, then I would suggest jumping to #5 below at this point and then combining again.

5. This is optional only if you need individual pdfs:

From the Thumbnail menu, choose, "Extract Pages as Separate Files" and "Page Label to Name Files."
