Issue

Solution

There are two methods of making the Object Properties window visible again.

Method #1

Edit the Windows® registry:

- Edit the entry with the value name {6D32A2D9-832E-11D2-A83C-0060B0872C0B}. For a 1024 x 768 pixel screen resolution, use value data of 3 689 58 337 569 1 to set the Properties window to the docked position.
- 3. Exit the Registry Editor.
