This forum is not officially monitored by Autodesk employees. Some may participate from time to time on their own initiative. I don't believe Autodesk is working on a fix since they view it as a workflow issue.

Some of the recommendations for workflow can help. Things like using Xrefs and Drefs extensively. Also don't keep any cogo points in the surface drawing than you have to. Most should be kept in an external file and <u>added to the surface</u> that way.
