

## How to display a picture in Advanced Print View

- 1. In advance print view choose the element you want.
  - a. In this example its "-basic"





- 2. Find the "\${}" equal to the value of the picture field.
  - a. In this example its \${item.itemDetails.sections["basic"].fields.PICTURE.value}
  - b. Copy "\${}" to a text editor (do not use word).



- 3. Copy <img src="/servlets/ImageServlet/?imageid=" hight="60"> to line 2 of the text editor.
  - a. Add line one of the text editor into line two of the text editor, after the ?imageid= and copy into line three

Copy line three and replace the item in the main element
