
## Advanced Functionality within your A360 hub

# **Uploading 3D Models & Assemblies**

- To upload a File that references other Files, you'll want to use the "Assembly" upload option.
- These files could be things like Revit Models, or Inventor Assemblies, or even OBJ files, however, there are a few steps that you must take first to ensure a successful upload.
- Put all files in same folder (parent and children).
- Verify link paths in parent file that they correctly reference children now that they've moved into the same folder.
- 3. From the Project folder, select **Upload**.
- 4. Select **Assembly**.




- 5. Choose the Parent file.
- 6. Select Upload.
- Tip: If you're using AutoCAD, you can use **eTransmit** to package all files up first to simplify steps 1 and 2 for you, or **Pack and Go** for Inventor assemblies.

### Moving Projects to another hub


Leverage the Transfer Project function to transfer projects across various A360 hubs.

- Projects can be transferred from A360 Free to A360 Team and from A360 Team to A360 Team hubs only.
  - Project Transfer does
     not support transfer
     from A360 Team to A360
     Free hubs.
- Only Administrators of A360
   Hubs are able to transfer projects across hubs.
  - For A360 Free hubs, the hub owner is able to transfer projects.



- Whoever initiates the project transfer should be an Admin of the Source hub and a Member (Admin/Team Member) of the Destination hub.
- User should be part of multiple hubs in order for the Transfer Projects option to show up.
  - o If the User owns or administers only a single hub, the Transfer Project option will not be available.
- Once Project Transfer is initiated, all content in selected project will be transferred to a Secret project of the same name in the destination hub.
- All members of selected project will be invited as **Project Contributors**, unless they are already Team members of the destination hub.
- Once Project is moved, all content will be deleted from Source hub and project will only be in Destination hub.
- Currently, the Transfer Projects option is disabled for C4R Enabled hubs.



### Using the Calendar

Create single or multi-day Events, add them to your local calendar, and forward them onto your Team.

1. Select your project then the Calendar icon.





- Select the day(s) for your event.
- 3. Select +Add.
- 4. Complete the Title, Time and Location information.
- Select Create to add the event to your online calendar as well send you a direct email.

6. Open email and save event to your local email system via the .ics file.

**Tip**: Calendar invites are **NOT** bidirectional, i.e. modifying your local invite will **NOT** update the event in the A360 Calendar.

**Tip**: Click on any existing event to **edit** it. Once saved, it will send another direct email along with an updated .ics file so that you can update your local calendar.





# Leveraging Live Review


Share your designs directly from A360 using the Live Review function to any person(s) on your team.


- 1. Select Share icon.
- 2. Select Live Review.
- 3. Add Name, select Start.
- 4. Select "+" to show hyperlink you'll send to those you want to add into your session.
- Copy link.
- Email link to individual or team.

7. See additional Team Members join Live Review Session.

**Tip**: A red dot will appear on screen signifying persons curser that is manipulating the design.

- 8. **Comment** icon allows visibility to the current message feed.
- 9. **Enter** and **Send** your own instant messages to the team.
- 10. Select **End** at any time to leave the Live Review session.
