### Expert Elite Shout-out section



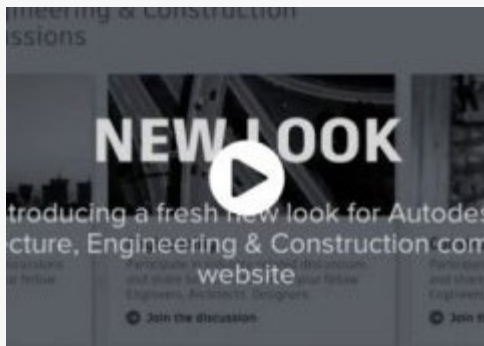
