- **WORK TO BE COMPLETED**
 - Site Preparation And Mobilization.
 - Maintain And Remove Safety Measures (Type I Barricade (Warning Marker), Type II Low-Profile Barricades Continuous) Refer To Note 5 Of The Miscellaneous Phase Note On This Sheet.
 - Mill/Remove Asphalt Pavement.
 - Construction Of New Storm Sewer Pipe & Manholes.
 - Construction Of New Concrete.
 - Construction Of New Asphalt.
 - Pavement Marking.
 - Erosion Control Measures
 - Clean Work Area Pavements, Site Restoration, And Removal Of Safety Measures
- **WORK AREA PAVEMENT CLOSURES:** Refer To Phase 1 Plan View
- **LIGHTING, SIGNS, AND MARKINGS:** Project Does Not Affect Any Existing Airport Lighting, Signs, Or Markings.
- **HAZARD MARKING AND LIGHTING:** Equipment To Have Lighted Beacons Or Airport Checkered Flags
- **BARRICADE LOCATIONS:** Place Barricade Line BC As Shown In Plan View This Sheet. Refer To Type I And Type II Barricade Details On Sheet 5 (CSPP-2).
- **ACCESS LOCATION:** Access Point (Gate G23), Contractor Shall Provide An Airport-Trained Gate Guard At All Times When Gate Is In Use. Contractor Shall Provide An Airport-Trained Gate Guard At All Times When Gate Is In Use
- **STAGING AREA:** The Contractors Staging Area For Phase 1 Shall Be Within The Phase 1 Work Area. The Contractor Shall Coordinate Construction Activity And Equipment/Material Staging As Necessary.
- **HAUL ROUTE:** Refer To Plan View.
- **ALLOWED WORK HOURS:** 7 Days A Week (Mon.-Sun.), 24 Hours/Day
- **AIRCRAFT TAXI:** The Apron Construction Area And Vehicle Service Road Is Closed To Aircraft. Adjacent Taxiway Shall Remain Open At All Times.
- **MISCELLANEOUS PHASE NOTES:**
 - 1 No Equipment Shall Be Allowed Beyond Contractor Work Area Depicted On This Sheet Unless Otherwise Approved By Owner's Representative.
 - 2 All Safety Measures For Current Phase Shall Remain And Be Maintained In Place, Unless Otherwise Approved By Owner/Owner's Representative, Until All Work Is Complete And New Facilities Are Turned Over To Owner.
 - 3 Temporary Erosion Control Measures Shall Remain In Place Until The Project Is Completed And All Cleanup Is Complete.
 - 4 Contractor Employees Shall Park All POV's Within The Designated Area Illustrated On This Sheet.
 - 5 Solid Connected Barricades Shall Be Placed Around The Entire Work Area Under Construction And Must Remain Until All Work Is Complete And Area Is Cleaned.
 - 6 All Work Must Be Complete Prior To August 31, 2016.
 - 7 Coordinate Phases Schedule And Limits With Atlantic Aviation To Keep Hangers In Operation.
